Bloomington... Dan Brady today announced to the people of Central Illinois that he will seek reelection to the Illinois House of Representatives in 2012. However, under the recent remapping, Dan will seek to serve in the newly drawn 105<sup>th</sup> House District. That District includes Normal, portions of East Bloomington, Carlock, Towanda, Lexington, Hudson, Gridley, Chenoa, Cooksville, Colfax, and Anchor. The Eastern boundary of the district stretches over to Fairbury, Forrest and Strawn in Livingston County. Central Illinois Regional Airport and Illinois State University are also part of the 105<sup>th</sup> District.

Dan believes the work he has done and relationships he has fostered over the past 10 years representing the 88<sup>th</sup> District transfer naturally to the geography comprising the 105<sup>th</sup>.

Advising of his intentions Dan said: "Helping people in the cities of Bloomington and Normal has been a privilege but political forces outside my control force me to think about where I can be most effective. I look forward to expanding into McLean and Livingston Counties and embracing new opportunities to serve."

In his time in Springfield Dan has risen through the ranks to assume a leadership position in the Republican caucus and presently serves as Assistant Republican Leader in the Illinois House. He also serves as Republican Spokesman on the House Executive and Election and Campaign Reform Committees.

His efforts in the legislature have been recognized by the Illinois Chamber of Commerce with the 2010 "Champion of Free Enterprise" Award; the National Federation of Independent Business for Illinois named him "Guardian of Small Business"; the Illinois Farm Bureau presented him with the "Friend of Agriculture" award; and the Illinois State Alliance of YMCA's gave him the "Legislative Hero Award".
